


# CALLERS CORNER



The new dance season has started and lessons are in full swing. New dancers will be going out to halfway dances and soon after that to regular club dances. It is imperative that both clubs and callers recognize the importance of being friendly and supportive to our new members.

Going out to those first few dances can be pretty intimidating to new dancers. The fear of making mistakes and goofing up the square can be strong and the embarrassment can be quick and paralyzing to new dancers. Sometimes it's easy to forget how we felt years ago when we graduated and started going to dances, or how hard we had to concentrate to get thru a tip. Experienced dancers need to also understand that the level the caller calls may dip a little as new dancer's first start coming to dances. That is a small price to pay to help keep our activity going.

Bringing new dancers into our square dance activity can be a difficult task, but keeping them can be even harder. New dancers are the life blood of square dancing, without them we have to call upon the same people to be officers, filling positions many have completed more than once or twice. As a caller I have had clubs fold that on the surface seemed to be doing great. They always had big crowds, a good place to dance, plenty of money in the treasury, but no new dancers. That caused the same people to have to take offices too often, to the point of the overworked dancers saying let's just fold the club.

So as the new dancers come out to our dances, let all of us make them feel welcome not just to the dance, but to our squares as well. Don't grab them, or try to push them into place. More often than not that just makes matters worse. Try to be helpful and encouraging without too much physical help. Remember that Square Dancing is Fun and Friendship set to Music.
